98.5-02 ISB Injector Install

Tools needed

3/8 Drive 3" Extension 7/16 Deep Torque Wrench 0-40 lbs. Torque Wrench Inch-lbs. Sockets 8mm, 10mm, 13mm, & 15mm Wrenches 19mm or ¾ Combination Needle Nose Pliers Medium Size Flat Blade Screwdriver

- 1. Please clean engine while cold. Pay close attention to Injector lines at the head. Its important to keep dirt from injection system. Don't do the install with the engine dirty or wet.
- 2. Remove intake air horn and heat grid. Remove mount from dip stick tube. Loosen 7/16 nut on charge air boot.



3. Remove APPS and set it off to the side.



4. There are injector line retaining brackets. See Pictures.

5. Using 8mm socket loosen line supports. See Pictures.



- 6. Remove rear engine lifting bracket (15mm socket)
- 7. Loosen 19mm jam nuts that hold connector tubes to the side of injector body.



- 8. Remove valve cover. Pushing down on the leader hose, slide valve cover up and left.
- 9. Remove 8mm bolts on injector hold downs.
- 10.Start at closest injector to you. Practice makes the rear ones easier. Using 1 of the valve cover bolts, thread into the top of the injector body. Now remove the connector tube and pry/lift upward to remove the injector. Be sure to inspect the connector tube to ensure that there are no cracks or contamination.



- 11.If you are switching nozzles over, then complete the following steps, if not then skip to step 15.
- 12. Secure the injectors with the nozzle facing upward and using a 14mm wrench/socket remove the nozzle nut. Inspect the sealing surface of the nozzle and ensure there are no cracks on the injector body or nozzle nut.



- 13. With a clean injector, install your new nozzle now and torque the nozzle nut to 30 Ft-lbs.
- 14. Test Injector POP pressure and set to 290 BAR. If you do not have the ability to set the POP pressure, we have services available to do so. Call us for additional information.
- 15. Using the same valve cover bolt as an install tool, lube the Injector O-Ring.
- 16. With connector tube still removed, install injector and fully seat into cylinder head.
- 17.IMPORTANT Using a combination wrench on the top of the injector, gently twist side to side while installing and seating connector tube.
- 18.Install Injector hold down; When it's snug finish tightening the 19mm jam nut to 35 Ftlbs. Then torque injector hold down to 89 In-lbs.
- 19. Repeat process on remaining injectors.
- 20. Reinstall and tighten fuel lines and secure all mounting brackets.
- 21. Reinstall valve cover, APPS, Grid Heater, and Intake Air Horn.
- 22.Loosen any injector line and crank engine for approximately 15 seconds.

Wait 30 seconds before second attempt. If the engine begins to run or acts like its going to tighten the injector line, its likely that 2 of the lines will need to be bled before it will start.

Once engine starts rev to 1500 RPM for 1 minute. Bleeding of system should be complete now.

Shut off and restart. It should be as quick to start as normal. Double check your work. Enjoy a quieter smoother, more powerful engine.
